Have been receiving the arrow and have enjoyed reading it. Have especially enjoyed reading of the great improvement in the school since leaving there twelve years ago the 6th of this month. A blank has also been received here for Maud Bailly who is an aunt of mine. Maud died in 1903. She was married in 1901 to Benj. Prodecker. And was living in Ohio at the time of her death.
