6. What property in the way of land, stock, buildings or money do you have? I have of my own 14 head of cattle and 16 head of good horses. and 500 acres of land - not including my husband's.

7. Have you been in the Indian Service? In what positions? How long in each?

8. What other positions have you held since leaving Carlisle?

9. Tell me anything else of interest connected with your life:

I have four children three boys and 1 girl - my oldest boy is past five years old and had made up my mind to send him to Carlisle this fall, but changed my mind, as I have another boy that is four years old and I thought next fall that they both could go there to school together and it wouldn't be so lonesome for them. I received a letter from you some time ago but it seems as though, when a person has to work all the time with a whole house full of children it is mighty hard to get along to get time to do any writing, visiting or anything else. I do not live on the reservation at all. I live in the settlement here in Nebraska amongst good white people, and am know very well around our neighboring towns here. My husband is a hard working man, we hadnt a beautiful home, but always have plenty. Have all kinds of stock and land. I gave music lessons before I got married, but since being married I had to give it up as I had plenty to do with out giving any more lessons. but what ever I understood to do I did my best and honestly as Carlisle taught. I have never regretted ever going to school at Carlisle. I have been asked ever so much by people that I have met, where I went to school. Some of my own ^{husbands} relations here, said they wished they had half the education that I have got, and I feel proud to think that I went to Carlisle to school and am thankful that there is such a school as Carlisle as I have children that shall go there to school when old enough to go. Carlisle gives the

Education that a person
ought to have, and I do
not know of any other school
that can come up with Carlisle,

I owe a lot to Carlisle for
what it has done for me,
and am proud of myself and
Carlisle both. I hope that there
are other Carlisle graduates and
ex-Students that are as thankful
as I am for the Education that
I have got: I shall be glad to
get copies of papers from
dear old Carlisle. A person
never knows what a good school
like Carlisle does for them or
never appreciates until one leaves
the school and then one can
see what value it has been to

them. Hoping I have made
 satisfactory answers to their
 questions on the blank. I
 answered the best I could.
