But have returned and found the Indians partly civilized found frame houses well built barns all living on their own land. They are now building railroads through Reservation and so much hundred dollars are paid to owners of land through which the railroad is built, so many Indians are well off. Many are putting up little trading stores, others are busy on their farming.

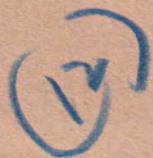
