Replying to your letter of December the 7th, this is to advise you that Dr. Ferdinand Shoemaker, who was formerly the Physician at this school, is now employed in the Indian Service to give his service on the various reservations as may be required. He has to travel a great deal and you can probably reach him with the least delay by addressing him in care of the Office of Indian Affairs at Washington, D. C.

Dr. Walter Renstorff is now the Physician here at Carlisle, but because neither one of the physicians named above can do much for you until they learn definitely what your trouble is I beg leave to suggest that you communicate with Superintendent Campbell at the Cheyenne River Agency in regard to your needs. You realize, of course, that the sooner treatment is given you the better it will be.

I am pleased to know where you are located and your record card here is being changed accordingly. Let us hear
