3. Did you attend or graduate from any other schools after leaving Carlisle? Give names of schools and dates if possible I entered the school for nurses at the Methodist Episcopal Hospital in Philadelphia and graduated on May the 24th 1897.

4. What is your present occupation? Nursing

5. Tell something of your present home We spend close to \$700 for a new house besides a new barn and chicken houses. We set out \$40 dollars worth of fruit and shade trees.

6. What property in the way of land, stock, buildings or money do you have? We have five quarter sections of land, cattle, horses, hogs and chickens. We have \$1,700 dollars in the bank at present.

7. Have you been in the Indian Service? In what positions? How long in each? I was appointed as a Field Matron and held my position until I took sick. I was in the service 3 yrs.

8. What other positions have you held since leaving Carlisle?

9. Tell me anything else of interest connected with your life:

I have been kept busy nursing ever since I came home because trained nurses are scarce. We have a very nice house which we had just built. We raise cattle ~~and~~ horses, and hogs, and by selling them we saved enough to live nicely all the time. That is we are never in want. My husband farms quite a big piece of ground every year, he has about 35 acres of corn which looks fine, and also got some fall wheat in which is coming up good. My husband is ~~one of the~~ ^a Genoa student. We got a garden spot which is not quite an acre and yet I raise all kinds of vegetables every year and by selling them I earn from 15 to 20 dollars besides keeping enough for our own use.
