month

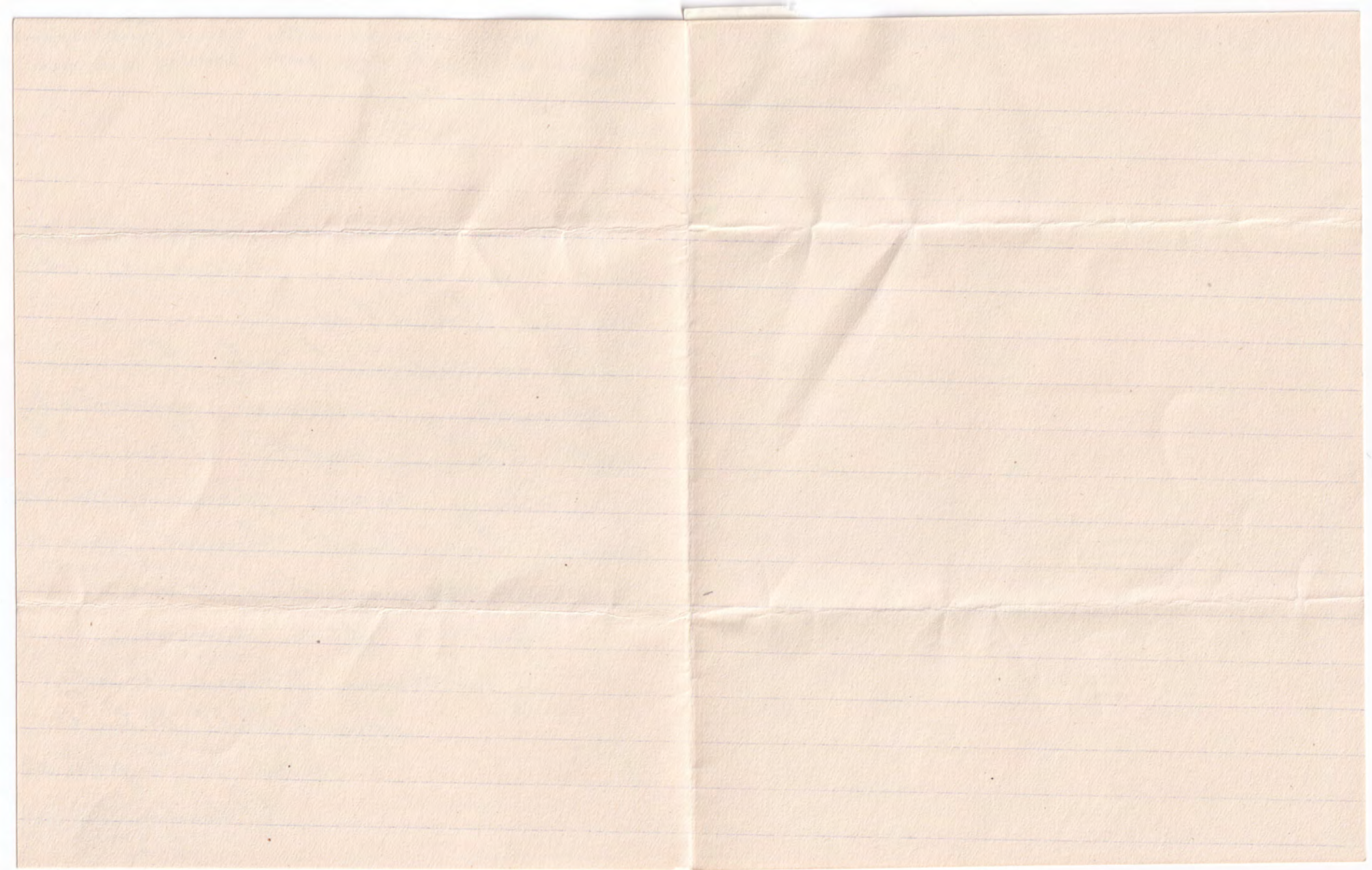

and I worked hard for it.

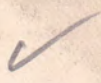
