As I am paying their transportation from Government funds, it will not be necessary for you to send any money.

I am sorry to inform you that Vera overstopped our rules the other evening during the time the pupils were having a lawn social. She went to a forbidden part of the grounds with one of the boys and was with him for quite a while. We have had to watch Vera very closely during the whole time she has been at Carlisle, and have never allowed her to go to an outing home after her first summer at Carlisle, and then because we felt we could not trust her with boys.
