1. Are you married and if so to whom?

Yes - I am married to Noble Prentice's a Carlisle Student.

2. What is your present address?

Warlington Okla.

3. Did you attend or graduate from any other schools after leaving Carlisle? Give names of

schools and dates if possible

I attend Shippensburg Normal Cumberland Valley Pa. In the year 1891 - was in Junior Class.

4. What is your present occupation?

Keeping house for my husband + family.

5. Tell something of your present home

My husband is employed by Uncle Sam and living on Government Reserve & in Government house.

6. What property in the way of land, stock, buildings or money do you have?

We each have 160 acres of land - have a team wagon & buggy, & a house on our allotment.

7. Have you been in the Indian Service? In what positions? How long in each?

Yes I was assistant Matron, Assistant Landress for a period of two years at the Arapaho school.

8. What other positions have you held since leaving Carlisle?

I am usually employed as an Interpreter at the big speaking meetings. I am holding at position such for this Baptist Church here at Darlington area.

9. Tell me anything else of interest connected with your life:

We have these Camp Meetings every year at the different Agencies - last year we held one at Red Rock - Okla. among the Kiowas Comanches, Apaches and Wichitas. It takes a good smart Interpreter for this place. and Our Baptist Missionaries here among the Cherokees, requests me to fill this important position paying me three dollars a day. I interpret to over two or three thousand Indians every year. Two or three times I have interpreted for the big Councils here at Darlington for the Government. What greater thing or better thing could I do for my people -
