Absolutely nothing. If following the teachings of Carlisle to make one's living away from reservations is helping "my people", you might give me the little credit I deserve. Since 1892 or 3 when I left Carlisle I spent but one year on a reservation at Fort Snelling in such cities as Chicago, Washington D.C. San Francisco Always as Clerk or typewriter excepting some three years spent as Nursery Guards in one family in S. F. and a year or two employed in a large Hospital in S. F.

But as for materially bettering "my
people" I have done nothing.
Age brings wisdom and I wisdom
brings ability and opportunities
I may get - and will if I can.
