Since 1892 or 3 when I left Carlisle I spent but one year on a reservation. Opportunities in such cities as Chicago, Washington D.C. San Francisco. Always as Clerk or typewriter excepting some three years spent as Nursery Groom in one family in S. F. and a year or two employed in a large Hospital in S. F.

But as for materially bettering "my
people" I have done nothing.
Age brings wisdom and wisdom
brings ability and opportunities
I may get - and will if I can.
