*a large number of our tribe have become citizens and we have been voters for some years.*

*The Govt. does not do very much for us financially*



considering what it does for other tribes. Therefore what we  
own we work for, and we work against odds too.

Our anxiety this year amounted to only 44 cts a piece.

We are to have a Rural Route this coming season, which  
will speak of the progressiveness of the Oneidas.

I have not a picture of my family home but here is  
one of the family. My wife is a Carlisle student  
and she is well posted for her people to help  
and well advanced as I am.

I am always glad to help Dear old Carlisle  
and am pleased I can do this much  
in helping to uphold Carlisle's standard.
