

and are once more back to their old Indian ways. They are better off in east because people in east take more interest in them than they do out here. When we first came to Okla. David tried to hunt work in Shaunce but there was no work. for him because he was on Indian. When me went on our farm people began to know him as a morker and an honest man. Now he has reached the stage where white

man is trading with an Indian, He is well respected in Shannee every-body knows him. We have two boys, One will be old enough to go to school with the white childern iset next year. The other one is year and half. We bought house and two lots here and I rather like city life for a change. Well I think I have written enough now so will close with best vishes from us your friends David - Margaret abraham. Remember us to our friend in the alumni association tell them of our doings.
