I am only one eighth Indian so I was despoiled of my rights on the Omaha Reservation. I went to South Dakota and used my homestead rights and filed in one hundred and twenty acres of land. I lived there eleven months, prosed up and got my deed after that I got married and came to Nebraska again. My husband is farming one hundred and sixty acres of rented land about four miles north east of Bancroft in Thurston county.

My father mother and two brothers are at present on a homestead in ~~the~~ Mead county South Dakota. I have one <sup>brother</sup> and two sisters that have had homesteads and prosed up on them.
