

Dr. James E. Johnson, of the class of '03, and his wife, who is also an ex-student, are visiting here. Their home is at San Juan, Porto Rico, where Dr. Johnson is engaged in the practice of his profession. Durring the past year has business amounted to \$4000.00. He will be remembered as the famous All-American quarterback and captain of the football team in 1903. After leaving Carlisle he graduated from the Northwestern University. Mrs. Johnson is employed by the Bureau of Education at Porto Rico, as stenographer and typewriter, at a salary of \$1200 a year.
