Our means have always been limited, but we have endeavored to help our people but good example.

When we first came home we started a henry, bought incubators and eggs, and had good luck with our hatches.

Out of seven hundred grown until large enough to eat, we lost all but twenty six by fall. Our

neighbors feasted on them.
We gave it up for that time
but just as soon as we go on our
own farm that will be a part of
my work.
