Two years ago mother died & left me the home we owned and now I rent that and keep on doing housework for others. ~~and~~ This summer I am going to do record work for a wealthy family who have a home on the Island and comes up only for the season which opens up in June & closes in September. This is the third summer this lady tried to get me for that work and as I had not engaged myself to any one else since came ⁱⁿ home from Northern Michigan I accepted the position. The Island is a

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great summer resort, as
