

That would mean that he completed perhaps a little bit in ~~advance~~ of the average of Grade VIII in the average state of the Middle West. From a rather vague entry by my predecessor on Cloud's card at this office, I take it that Cloud attended Conway for a year after graduating here, I would suggest that you inquire of Dr. Hutchinson. If Cloud attended there, the work done by him there would be the highest ever done by him, so far as we can ascertain, in this locality. It would seem that Cloud's record is good, although I have nothing on record down here aside from data relative to his academic standing.
