My dear Friend:-

After receiving your letter asking for help, I immediately took up the matter of ascertaining your exact condition and what you needed. I am very sorry that you are ill and in destitute circumstances, and I want to help you. I have had reports from William Garlow and Dr. Allen, and I think I understand just how you are fixed.

Dr. Allen is of the opinion that it would be best for you to go to the Sanitarium. I feel very confident that we can get you in, and while you may have some discomfort at first, there is no question but what you will rapidly get better there.

I am very much interested in you because you are a former student of the school, although the Government is not in a position to help you. Some friends of mine may be able to assist you financially from time to time, but I feel that the first thing for you to do is to go to the Sanitarium where you will get special treatment, and be

the best kind of a location for a man with your disease. You should make immediate application to the dispensary to gain admission in the Mt. Alto Sanitarium. I am writing you for your best interests, as I am not only anxious for you to get well yourself but to be in a position to look after your family. You should be willing to put up with any inconvenience at present for the ultimate sake of regaining your health.
