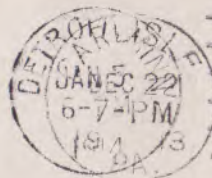

\$4.50 per month which I work
for him for four month made
me \$180.00 I Blacksmith
different place in N. Dak
such towns Grand Forks, N. D.
Grafton N. D. Calver N. D.

White Fish Mount. Conr. dealer
Idaho for big four Lumber & Co
for B. R. Lewis Lumber & Co at Camp
Bellgrove Idaho. And This gives
me a position of Blacksmithing at
