I am very sorry and fear that I couldn't
do you any favor, which you required me
to do, for this reason. "It has been
several years ago when I wrote a letter to
Carlisle Indian School, for me to return
and complete my term at the school, also
I made a promise to the school, that I
would remain at school, until completing
my term at school.

Later I realize of my refusal by not
getting any answer from the school.

Although I couldn't give the Government
Schools any credit for my schooling, but

I could give myself Credit for
my way through the World, in
last seven, ^{or more} years.

In September 14th 1909 I arrived
this reservation, after I have been absent
from, for the last ten years.

I will close by asking you to not have
a disagreeable feeling for my disfavor.
