Her account was closed Sept. 5th, 1910 by check No. 11209 in the sum of 30.09. Subsequently interest was credited to her in the sum of 37 cents which was sent her by check No. 12637 Dec. 2nd, 1910. Both these checks have been paid. Her account at no time ever exceeded \$30.09, although it covers a period of almost four years.
