Replying to your letters dated the 24th of Sept and 9th of December, I have to advise you an error was made when I wrote you Aug. 21st that the account of Mary Silas was closed by a check for 26.67 dated October 19th, 1910. This was another Mary Silas from DePere, Wis. The Mary Silas you are inquiring about I find left Carlisle Oct. 7th, 1895 account ill health.

She never had much money in bank, the total amount being 11.94

which was paid her as follows,

October	expressage-----	.30
October	sub. Indian helper,	.10
Oct. 4th, 1895	cash-----	2.00
October 7th,	cash-----	5.17
