Mr. Chas Buck, 2 Bay Hampton &  
Melcom Clark, 4 Levi Burd, 6  
Joe Avers, (Eddie Running Crane  
Chas Curly Bear; These are the  
following pupils who gradu-  
ate, from Carlisle) and they  
have good Records here just  
the same when they was at



Carlisle; and they are all with  
 of the Blackfoot, first is a little  
 one, and Fair horses, and  
 nice frame house; and also  
 takes positions in government  
 work and receives good Salary,  
 Second; Owns a large little  
 Ranch and horses and frame  
 house and also he takes position  
 in government work; and  
 sometimes makes speeches to  
 the Indians give advice,  
 Third he also owns a cattle  
 ranch; and horses; and  
 takes positions in government  
 work; and a Chief Clerk,

forth, he also owns a large cattle  
Ranch; and some horses and  
takes possions in government  
work; and sometimes make speech  
to the Indians and give them  
advice; fifth, takes possion  
in the United States Recla-  
mation Service; and get  
good Salary; and sometime  
make the Surveyors; Sixth,  
he work for the store; as what  
you call Clerk; and get good  
Salary; and sometime make  
speech to the Indians,  
and sometime Bookkeeper,

and Beverth; he also a Clerk  
 he write names for pople write  
 ing names in pimmiships  
 as you call and also Chief Clerk  
 and that shows what Carlisle  
 work done for these people; and  
 I think that art to pay  
 to aducate and pndians  
 and I think Carlisle turns  
 out good American Citizens  
 and Civilized pople; and  
 my self I an't graduates from  
 Carlisle; but I do the best  
 I can for that blank what  
 you send me; Good bye  
 I wish you happy New Year,  
 and Merry Christmas!
