Emma Burrows French, wife of William French, died Monday at their home in Phoenix of tuberculosis. Mrs. French was a Mohave Apache, daughter of Yuma Mike, and graduated at Carlisle. After returning from the East she was employed at the Phoenix Indian school until her marriage to William French, a progressive young Maricopa and former student of this school. They have been thrifty and built a nice little home on East Jefferson which was kept on model plan by the wife and mother. The death of two children was a sorrow which came to the French home within the past two years, and which perhaps aggravated the already failing health of Mrs. French. The funeral was held Wednesday from Merryman's parlors.
