3 children

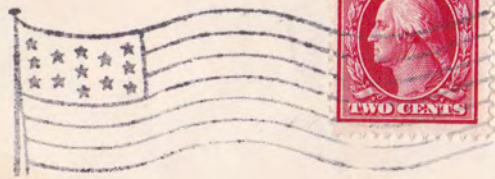
a finer woman or a better wife & mother narrow
