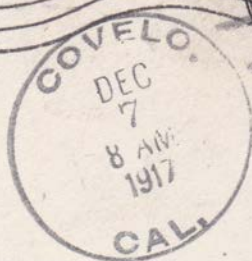

I am glad to know I can sew neat and keep a good house I owe all the good qualities from the Indian schools of which I am very grateful, which I will never forget. I would be very please to get those literature you spoke of.
