a position in the Warehouse Department as a clerk, for "The Old Dominion Copper Mining and Smelting Company" at Globe, Arizona.

Since my returning from Carlisle, I have not done any thing for the betterment of my people. Only now and then I encourage the old folks to have all of their children to attend the school.

Also I have a conversation with some of the students concerning the new Reservation school. I have encouraged them to go and attend the new Reservation school, but I

have not succeeded so far.

12. Tell me anything else of interest connected with your life

I only wish that every child on the Reservation would go and attend "The Carhile, Indian Industrial School" and graduate at the school. And then my people would be on the same level with the Eastern Indians as far as civilization is concerned.

I think I have done well since my returning from Carhile. I have worked for "The Old Dominion Copper Mining and Smelting Company" as a clerk for two years and a half. For the first six months my wages was \$60. per month and afterward it was raised to \$75. and then \$90. and at last increased to \$100. per month. If you have any doubt I advise you to get information from the Superintendent of the said company that I have
